How to get to LGT branch in Vienna

By car

You will find an electronic route planner to every LGT address at www.lgt.at.

From the north

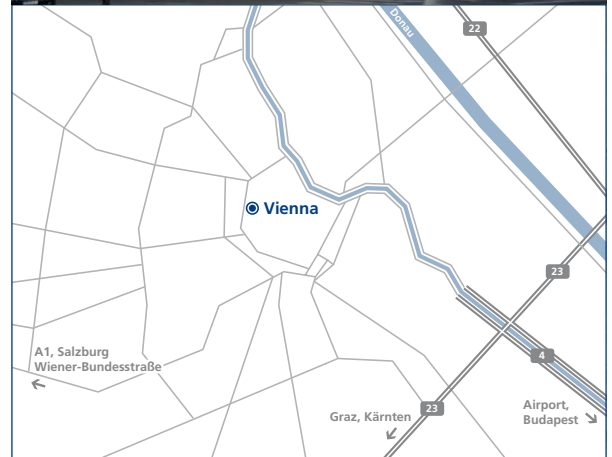
- Take the A22 motorway, direction Zentrum (center). Cross the Nordbrücke bridge and then drive along Nußdorfer Lände, Heiligenstädter Lände and Franz-Josefs Kai.
- Turn right before the Urania. You are now on Ringstraße.
- Follow Stubenring and Parkring, then cross Schwarzenbergplatz in the direction of the Opera.
- Turn left at the parliament building. Follow the road for about 10 meters and you will see the entrance to the Rathausplatz car park.

From the south (Graz, Kärnten, A23)

- Take the A23 motorway, direction Budapest. Follow the signs for the airport, taking the exit for Gürtel.
- Follow the signs for Gürtel. Turn right after the Belvedere Castle into Prinz-Eugen-Straße.
- At the end of the Prinz-Eugen-Straße cross the Schwarzenbergplatz and turn into Ringstraße.
- Follow Stubenring and Parkring, then cross Schwarzenbergplatz in the direction of the Opera.
- Turn left at the parliament building. Follow the road for about 10 meters and you will see the entrance to the Rathausplatz car park.

From the east (airport, Budapest, Bratislava, A4)

- Take the A4 motorway in the direction of Zentrum (center), going over Schüttelstraße and Untere Donaustraße.
- Then take a left turn and cross the Aspernbrücke (Aspern Bridge). Drive straight along Ringstraße.
- Follow Stubenring and Parkring and then continue in the direction of the Opera.
- Turn left at the parliament building. Follow the road for about 10 meters and you will see the entrance to the Rathausplatz car park.

By public transport

From the airport

- At the airport, follow the green signs for the City Airport Train (CAT).
- The trains depart every 30 minutes. The journey to Wien Mitte station takes 16 minutes non-stop.
- From Wien Mitte take the U3 line in the direction of Ottakring and travel 3 stops.
- Alight at Minoritenplatz. Cross the Minoritenplatz, heading in the direction of Bankgasse.

From the Westbahnhof (Vienna West Train Station)

- At the Westbahnhof, follow the signs for the U3 line.
- Take the train in the direction of Simmering. Alight at Herrengasse Station.
- Take the Minoritenplatz exit. Cross the Minoritenplatz, heading in the direction of Bankgasse.
